5. Examine the factors which were responsible for the failure of Settler farming in Uganda during the colonial period. *(25 marks)*
6. Describe the economic and social changes that took place in Tanganyika between 1875 and 1914. *(25 marks)*
7. Account for the religious conflicts in Uganda during the late 19th century. *(25 marks)*
